All grants are specified for enrollment and attendance in an engineering or science program related to mining at a school in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania or State of New Jersey.

Instructions for completing scholarship application:

1. Complete the Scholarship Application by answering all the questions.

Graduating Senior

2. Obtain a certified copy of your high school transcript indicating your courses for the first semester of the 12th grade.
3. Be sure your SAT or ACT scores are included on your transcript or attach a copy of the official test report.
4. Have your Guidance Counselor include a description of the curriculum and grading system used, and indicate on the transcript those courses in progress for the first semester of the 12th grade. Also clearly indicate on the transcript all courses that are included in the high school "honors" or "advanced placement" programs, any courses completed from a college or university curriculum for which high school credit is earned, and credits earned from a special industry program.
5. Be sure to have your Guidance Counselor or Principal complete the appropriate portion of application and submit under separate cover to address below.

2. Obtain a certified copy of your transcript indicating your courses up to the first semester of the school year.

Student Checklist

- Test scores have reached at least the minimum score indicated on the application

- Student is Pennsylvania or New Jersey Citizen
- Counselor or principal has signed application
- Student has signed application
- Student has applied to a mining-related engineering or science program, i.e. mining engineering, mineral economics, mineral processing, geology, environmental geology at a school in Pennsylvania
- Certified transcript is included and signed by the counselor or principal with explanation of the grading system and curriculum
- Student has kept a copy of the application
